



Late Pick-Up/After Care Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

- The After Care program and procedures also apply to students in the Sister Carolyn Learning Center in PreK 2 & PreK 3. Students in PreK 4 will be going to the SCLC for After Care.
- The Late Pick-Up/After Care program is necessary because teachers need to have all students in their classroom dismissed either via carline, or to the Late Pick-Up classroom promptly at their dismissal time in order to resume their job responsibilities at the end of the school day.
- Enrolling your child in the Late Pick-Up/After Care program ensures that all students remaining in the building are safely accounted for and supervised by our staff for the time beyond dismissal.
- The Late Pick-Up program is being offered to those families who cannot pick-up their child at the first dismissal time or have a younger sibling that needs to wait for an older sibling getting dismissed in the second dismissal.
- Parents who do not wish to pay the fee for the Late Pick-Up program and have students being dismissed in both the first and second dismissal, would need to make the first carline to pick-up at the first dismissal and then make the second carline to pick-up at the second dismissal.
- Carline will end promptly at 3:05 PM, at which time students need to be registered in our After Care program if they need to stay in school past that time.
- Those students staying after school for clubs/sports still need to register for After Care but will not need to pay a fee. Please state on the registration form the sport/club that they are staying after school. However, the full Late Pick-Up/After Care fee does need to be paid if the student will be staying after their designated dismissal time on the other days of the week when the student is not participating in any after school enrichment activity.
- Late Pick-Up/After Care fees must be pre-paid before each semester (August-December & January-June) begins.
- Late Pick-Up/After Care will NOT be offered on early dismissal days. On those days, students will need to be picked-up at the 12:00PM early dismissal time to ensure that all our teachers and staff are able to attend professional development opportunities to better serve our students.
